Honeydew honey, in other words, made from the sugary secretion of insects that feed on plant sap. It is collected and processed by bees. The result is a very dark honey, slightly less sweet than other honeys.

The sugary secretion of insects is collected and preserved. The plants used for the production of honeydew honey, in our geographic areas are mainly conifers (white and red firs, pines, and larch).
